## The Project

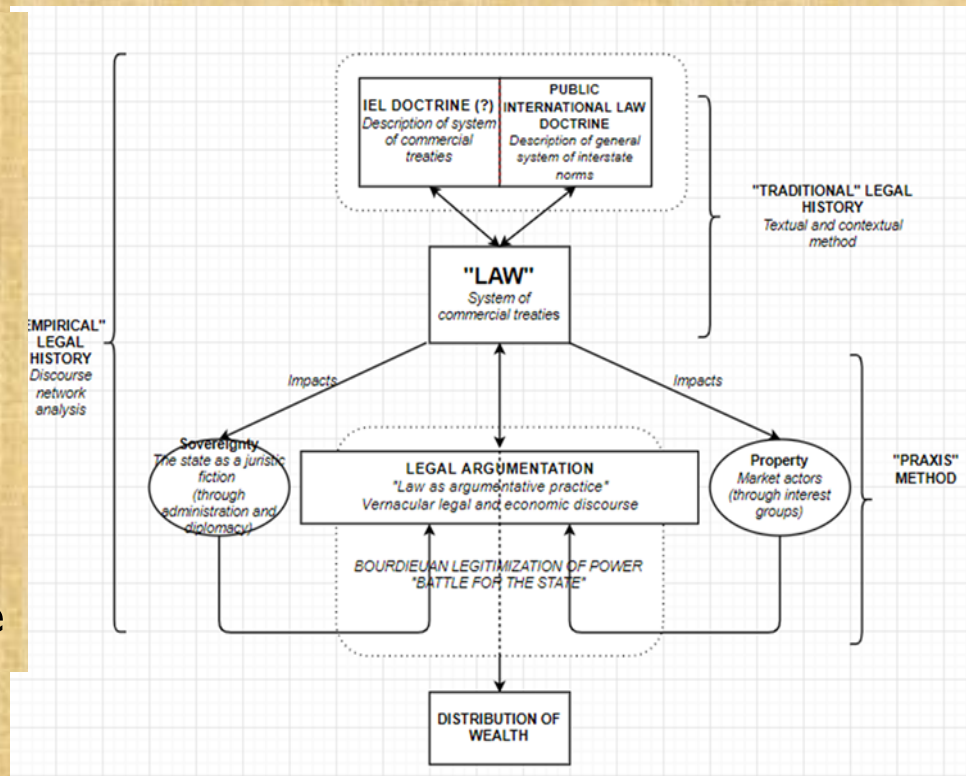
- 1860-1870: creation of the first “Common Market” in Europe

## Research Q's

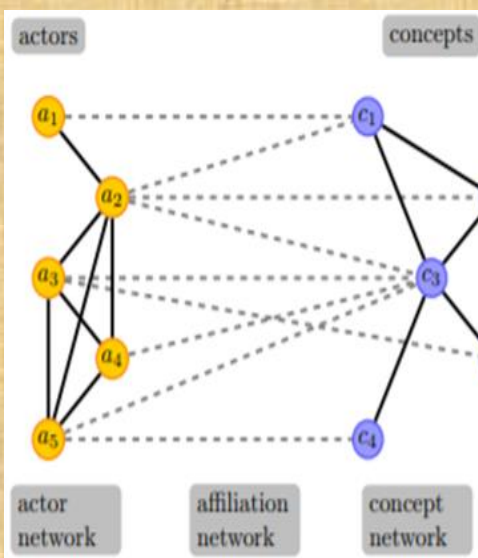
- Key clauses in European treaty practice

- Contextual genealogy of doctrine
- Law as an argumentative practice

## Digital LH: Discourse Network Analysis

- Combines qualitative content analysis w/ quantitative network analysis
- Similar units of thought are labelled with a code
- Thought units are linked to actors
- Program in R: rDNA
